

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Hot Weather Policy

All students must wear a sun safe hat at all times outdoors. A policy of no hat no play applies. Children are encouraged to wear sunscreen. Sunscreen is available in all classrooms for students to apply before they go out to play at lunchtime.

In cases of extreme heat (36 degrees or above) children stay indoors during lunchtime. The temperature will be determined by referring to “Willy Weather” at 11:15am (lunch) and 1:45pm (recess).

3 blasts on the siren will indicate to children that they are to remain inside.

Wet Weather Policy

On days when wet weather prevents outside play, children will remain indoors.

No child will be outdoors during a thunderstorm.

If the wet weather occurs during outside play periods, a siren will be sounded at the discretion of the teacher on duty in the Primary Asphalt area.

- 3 blasts on the siren will indicate to children that they are to return to their classroom.
 - Inside supervision is shared between adjoining teachers.
 - NIT teachers will support classroom supervision.
 - The library will be closed.

- One blast on the siren will indicate that rain has stopped and that children may return to play.
