

ATHELSTONE SCHOOL DRESS CODE POLICY

It is the policy of the school community that students attending Athelstone Schools R-7 follow the School Dress Code. School Dress Code means colour- coded mix'n'match blue and white clothing.

Navy blue and white are the designated school colours at Athelstone Schools.

1. The wearing of School Dress clothing by all students positively promotes good school tone.
2. It is important that students wear comfortable, hard wearing, easy to move in clothing so they are able to participate fully in the activities provided at the school.
3. It is the responsibility of parents to see that students wear the correct School Dress Code.
4. Unavoidable temporary variations in School Dress should be advised in writing in the diary by parents and dated.
5. Rainproof clothing is the only item accepted in non-school colours and must be removed once indoors.
6. School logos are encouraged but optional. Large or small commercial logos on clothing are not permitted.
7. Students on school excursions will comply with the School Dress Code or will not be allowed to attend unless alternative arrangements (due to the nature of the activity) have been made with the teacher and/or the principal.

School Dress Clothing

The school dress code is defined by items chosen from:

- Navy blue or white long/short sleeved polo shirt or skivvy
- Plain navy blue for windcheaters, jumpers or jackets
- Plain navy blue trousers, track pants (no stripes) or shorts –no denim
- Navy blue skirts, pinafore, skorts or netball skirts- no denim
- Navy blue and white gingham dress (summer)
- Sports briefs or bike pants are encouraged when girls wear netball skirts or dresses
- Navy blue sun safe hat- legionnaire, wide brim or surf hat (brushed cotton)
- Jewellery- sleepers, studs (in ears only) and watches are the only acceptable/safe jewellery
- No make-up or nail polish is permitted
- Designated senior windcheater for Year 7 students (new design each year)

Please Note: All tops to have sleeves and should be long enough so as to cover midriff.
